<p>Imagine you were there when Tutankhamun's tomb was discovered. Write a newspaper report about the findings. LO: To demonstrate an understanding of the features of newspaper writing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can include direct quotes written in the first person. I can include reported speech. I can include a range of diary or report features in writing (headline, introduction, main body of text, closing paragraph). 	<p>Research holidays to Egypt online. Budget how much it would cost to go on holiday with your family. LO: To apply my understanding of the four operations of number to a real-life problem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use rounding, approximation and estimation. I can use written methods for addition and subtraction. I can calculate using numbers with at least four digits. 	<p>In Ancient Egypt, Egyptians used a <u>shaduf</u> to lift water to irrigate the land. Research the use of the shaduf, then design, label and make your own shaduf. LO: To investigate the science behind a shaduf.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can explain the forces used in a shaduf. I can make a working model shaduf. 	<p>Pyramids were an important part of Ancient Egyptian life and afterlife. LO: To design and make a model pyramid.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can research some Ancient Egyptian pyramids. I can draw and label a design pyramid. I can make the pyramid using art, craft and design techniques. 	<p>Create a fact file on a famous Ancient Egyptian. LO: To write a fact file.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use the internet or books to identify a famous Ancient Egyptian. I can write key facts about the person.
<p>Write an acrostic poem using the letters of a key topic word, e.g. Egypt, Egyptian, Pharaoh... LO: To write an acrostic poem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can show I understand the structure of an acrostic poem. I can use expanded noun phrases and prepositional phrases. I can use similes, alliteration, metaphors and / or personification. 	<p>Write a recipe for a meal that could have been eaten in Ancient Egypt. LO: To write a recipe.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can include the correct units of measurement I can include the time it would take to prepare and cook the meal. As a challenge you could: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Try the recipe! - Work out how to scale the recipe up to create an Egyptian feast for 100 people. 	<p>Design your own experiment that investigates which material will decompose the least in soil, and so be better for the mummification process. You could try linen, toilet roll, newspaper...etc. LO: To investigate mummification.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can make a prediction about what I think will happen. I can design a method that will test this. I can show my results in a table or a graph. I can write a conclusion to show what I found out. 	<p>Jewellery was precious to people in Ancient Egyptian times. Design and make your own piece of jewellery. LO: To design and make a piece of Egyptian jewellery.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can research some of the jewellery found from Ancient Egypt. I can draw and label a design for my jewellery. I can make the jewellery using art, craft and design techniques. 	<p>Draw or trace a map of Egypt. Mark the important and famous landmarks on it. LO: To draw and label a map.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can include both physical and human geographical features. I can identify and label the capital city.
