
Personal, Social and Emotional

We will continue to build on the use of language for the children to express their emotions and communicate effectively with each other in the room. We will use 'busy learning time' to focus on group activities which involve negotiation and turn taking.

Understanding the World

We will be revisiting what the children have previously learned about life cycles continuing to plant and care for different types of plants. We will also be building on this knowledge by focusing on the life cycle of a caterpillar and developing their understanding of the key features of the life cycle.



Literacy

We will continue to have focused Phonics groups three times a week to build on the children's Phase 1 phonics skills. All children will be taking part in a weekly activity which involves either recognising and/or writing their names.

Physical Development

The children will have the opportunity to take part in daily gross/fine motor activities such as 'squiggle while you wiggle' and 'dough disco.'

We will continue to build on gross motor skills through our PE sessions where we will be revisiting and building on ball skills.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be using imaginative role play to consolidate their knowledge of the butterfly life cycle by acting it out. We will also be implementing a new role play area which is a shop for the children to act our narratives and build on their imaginative play together.

Maths

Communication and Language

We will focus on building the children's

vocabulary relating to our core story. We will

continue to revisit our learning of rhyming

through our daily story time sessions and

promote conversations based on the stories we

have shared together.

We will be revisiting our previous learning of patterns by creating patterns using different fruits, taking inspiration from our core story.

We will continue to implement Maths circle times three times a week to continue our focus on counting and recognising numbers.
