Dear Parents and Carers,

This half term we are going to continue to travel across the world to learn about the rainforests. We will find out all about the different animals who live in tropical rainforests - which will link closely to our trip for this term. We shall be making our very own rainforests in a box as well as creating prints of the rainforest in Art.

In English, we will be writing our very own persuasive letters to try and save parts of the rainforest. We will be using our own viewpoint, first person and persuasive language to convince people to change their minds. At the end of the term, we will be reading, performing and writing narrative poetry.

In Maths, we will be focusing on naming shapes and their properties and looking at different types of lines, angles and symmetry. After this we will be measuring the mass and capacity of different items to see how well we can read a scale or cylinder.
