

Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be consolidating the children's understanding of different ways to resolve conflicts through different scenarios. We will be revisiting the importance of independence to encourage children to complete tasks such as putting shoes and socks on, tending to their toileting needs and washing their hands.

Understanding the World

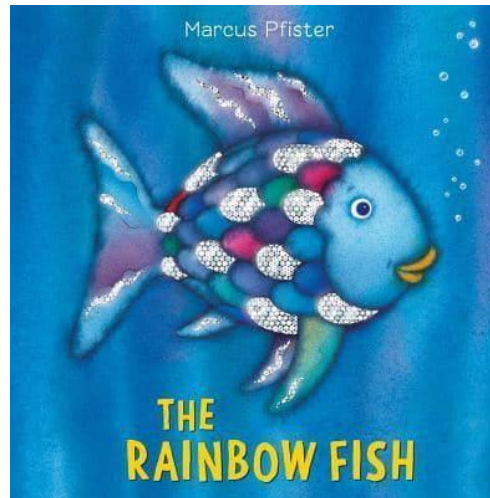
We will be exploring how things work by doing experiments involving sinking, floating and melting. We will discuss different ways of looking after our environment by recycling materials, as well as caring and respecting living things by linking it to our core book.

Literacy

We will revisit and practise Literacy skills such as rhyming, identifying initial sounds and clapping syllables. We will focus on writing some or all of their names and giving meaning to marks they make.

Communication and Language

We will be establishing opportunities for communication and language by creating a new role play area and new small world scenes. We will encourage conversation and children explaining their understanding linking to our core book and other 'under the sea' themed stories.



Physical Development

We will continue to inforce daily fine and gross motor practise through dough disco and squiggle while you wiggle, challenging them with more complex movements. We will explore weekly PE sessions where we will revisit ball skills and start taking part in some groups activities.

Maths

We will revisit and practise 1:1 correspondence by counting objects, as well as using their fingers, symbols and marks to show a number. We will create opportunities for children to learn and practise the skill of 'subitising' (developing fast recognition of up to 3 objects without having to count them).

Expressive Arts and Design

We will encourage and practise the children's mark making skills to draw with more complexity and detail. We will create opportunities for naming, exploring and playing different instruments to create their own music and songs. We will create open ended art activities which enable the children to express their ideas, selecting different materials they wish to use to do so.
