As Artists we will be making choices about which tools, resources and techniques they would like to use. We will learn to access and organise these independently, as well as tidy up afterwards! We will focus on using the media of textiles. We will focus on how water can be used with other materials to create art.

As Geographers we will find out about how water is represented on maps and globes. We will be thinking about the weather and the season of Summer.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be focusing on healthy lifestyles. We will be learning about how to make healthy choices to keep ourselves healthy, including keeping active, eating a healthy diet and making sure we get enough sleep.

As Mathematicians we will build numbers beyond 10. We will learn number patterns beyond 10. We will focus on shapes, matching shapes with different rotations and making shapes out of other ones.

We will be practising using different addition and subtraction strategies.

As Readers and Writers

We will focus on stories about different aspects of water – under the sea, pirates, seasides, mermaids, etc.

We will also read non-fiction (information) books and use them to find out facts.

We will use these books as a stimulus for writing for a range of different purposes. We will be listening to and writing our own poetry about water.

We will revise all learnt sounds and will practise using them to read and write words and sentences.

We will continue to practise our letter formation, ensuring the letters are formed correctly and are not too big or small.

As Computer Scientists: we will be investigating different programs, apps and websites on the chrome books, the Ipad, laptops and interactive board. We will think about how technology is used, both at school and at home.

As Scientists we will be learning about ways that water is used. Who or what needs water? Animals and plants?

We will explore floating and sinking and finding out about similarities and differences of materials. We will be looking at pollution of

water in our world.

We will be physical by joining in our swimming lessons where we will develop our water confidence and awareness of how to be safe in water. We will also be using different apparatus in the garden, including bikes, scooters, bats and balls and stilts.

As Historians we will be talking about past and present events in our own lives. We will think about how pirates lived and compare their ships with boats of today.
