Choose a book you enjoy and write a book review about it. Remember to include what the book is about (without giving away all of the plot), why you liked it, was there anything you didn't like about it? And who would you recommend it to? L.O. To think about what you are reading and why you like it.	Dan the detective looked for a number. He found a two-digit number less than 50. The sum of its digits was 12. Their difference was 4. What number did Dan find? Dan found a two-digit odd number. One of its digits was half the other. The number was greater than 50. What number did Dan find? Can you make up your own number problems to solve like Detective Dan. Try them out on your family! LO: Write whole numbers in figures; know what each digit represents	Make a poster or powerpoint about different types of rocks igneous, metamorphic and sedimentary. Remember to include the main differences, what they look like and how they were formed. LO: To use scientific vocabulary to create a factual information text	Draw a picture to show what it would have been like in the Stone Age. Choose whether your picture is of the palaeolithic, mesolithic or neolithic period and make sure you include what people might have looked like, what they might have worn, where they would have lived, where their food came from, and what the surroundings would have been liked (forest, fields, open plains etc) Label you picture with as much detail as you can. LO: I can use my knowledge of the Stone Age to produce a picture of what life might have been like	Decorate a big stone or a pebble with a design of your choice. If you can't find a stone to decorate, create your design in your homework book instead. Tell me why you have chosen that design! LO: I can design a pattern for a 3D image
