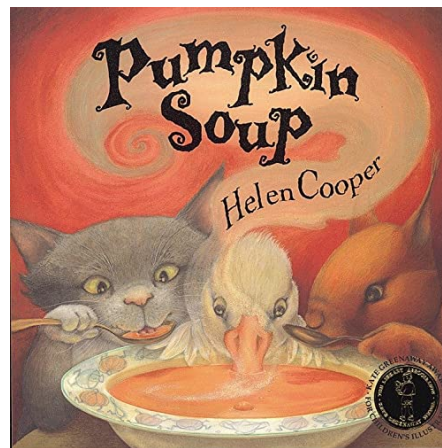
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Dear parents and carers,

## PE and Moat Days

As many of you already know, we go to the moat and do a PE session once per week. Each term I will alternate the day for these sessions to try and ensure every child has an opportunity to experience these.

**In Autumn Term 2 our moat session will be on Thursday mornings.** Please remember to send your child in warm clothing, wellies, waterproofs (if you have them) and as it gets colder, hats, gloves and scarves. Also please have a change of clothes and shoes in children's bags as they often get changed afterwards.

**The PE session will be on Friday mornings** so please send your child in comfortable clothing and shoes that they can take off and put on independently.

**In Autumn 2 we will visit the library in the Key Stage 2 block on Tuesday mornings.** This will give the children an opportunity to explore the wider school environment and promote sharing stories together. In this session the children will have an opportunity to choose a book from the library to take home to share. Please ensure your child brings their book back by the following Tuesday. They will not be able to borrow a new book without returning the old one.
