<p>Write a story from the perspective of a desert animal about what life is like in the desert and how they survive.</p> <p>Think about the structure and content of your story. How can you make it concise yet gripping?</p>	<p>Use an Atlas or the internet to find information about the height of different physical geographical features (such as mountains).</p> <p>Write your own one step or multi-step word problems about these and then show how you would solve them.</p>	<p>Create a poster/leaflet/presentation about arctic animals and explain how they are adapted to their environments.</p>	<p>Create a 3D model or mask of an animal/animals that live in a habitat of interest to you.</p>	<p>Find out about an extreme habitat (such as the ocean) and create a poster, leaflet or report about this area.</p> <p>Explain how animals are adapted to the conditions and what the conditions are like.</p>
<p>Remind yourself (or find out) what <i>homophones</i> are.</p> <p>Create a poster that would help someone remember when to use some commonly mistaken homophones, for example: there, their and they're and / or to, two and too</p>	<p>Find the area and perimeter of 5 objects in your home.</p> <p>As a challenge, try to include compound shapes.</p> <p>Remember: perimeter is the distance around a 2D shape.</p> <p>Area is the size of the surface of a 2D shape.</p> <p>Area of a rectangle = Length x Width.</p>	<p>Create a poster, leaflet, poem or powerpoint about the life cycle of an animal of your choice.</p> <p>Think about the scientific vocabulary you will need to include.</p> <p>This could be the life cycle of your favourite animal, an animal that hatches from an egg, an animal that goes through metamorphosis... it's up to you!</p>	<p>Find out about the leaves on different trees in the rainforest.</p> <p>Use these as an inspiration for a piece of art. For example, this could be a collage, mark making, print or painted in the style of an artist of your choice.</p>	<p>Find out about different explorers of extreme climates and write a report about them that shows what they did. For example, you could write about Ranulph Fiennes, Matthew Henson or Jeanne Baret.</p>
