You might want to write it from your own perspective, imagining that you have been accepted into the school!</p> <p>LO: To write a short story.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can write in first or third person throughout. I can include a range of sentence lengths and openers I can use powerful and imaginative vocabulary choices. 	<p>Create 5 mathematical word problems based on Harry Potter.</p> <p>LO: To apply understanding of problem solving when creating word problems.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can include clear answers explaining how to solve the problem. My problems use a mixture of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. I can use numbers with at least 3 digits. 	<p>At Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry, the children go to potions class. Design your own potion that shows a reversible or irreversible change.</p> <p>LO: To investigate reversible or irreversible changes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can design an experiment to show reversible or irreversible changes. I can record the stages of the experiment. I can write up a brief summary of my findings. 	<p>At Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry, the children are put into houses: Gryffindor, Hufflepuff, Ravenclaw, Slytherin. Create your own house.</p> <p>LO: To create an original crest.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can create a crest for my house. I can include a motto. I can include a brief description of the contents of my crest. 	<p>Investigate the locations that inspired J.K. Rowling's book and the locations the movie was filmed.</p> <p>LO: To investigate geographical features.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can name 4 locations that inspired J.K. Rowling's writing or locations Harry Potter was filmed. I can label the locations I found on a map. I can identify the features of the area that were important for the film.
<p>Write a review for the Harry Potter and Philosopher's Stone book or film.</p> <p>LO: To write a review.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can include some facts about the film. I can include how I felt about the film. I can include a rating for the film. 	<p>Create a set of top trumps cards based on Harry Potter.</p> <p>LO: To create a maths game.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can include 5 numerical facts. I can put a calculation instead of just the answer I can make a set of 10 cards. 	<p>At Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry, the children go to potions class. Design your own potion that requires dissolving and explain the process.</p> <p>LO: To investigate dissolving.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can design an experiment to show dissolving. I can record the stages of the experiment. I can write up a brief summary of my findings. 	<p>During the filming of Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone, many props were used. Design and make your own prop, eg. A wand, a chocolate frog box, a broom...</p> <p>LO: To design and make a prop.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can research some of the props used in the film. I can draw and label a design for a prop. I can make the prop using art and design techniques. 	<p>Create a timeline showing the progression of the Harry Potter franchise.</p> <p>LO: To create a timeline.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can include when J.K. Rowling started writing each of the books. I can include when all the books were published. I can include when the films were made.
