

Maths:

We will implement and execute daily opportunities to count and use number skills. We conduct 3 circle times per week with a Maths focus to teach Maths skills such as 1:1 counting, showing finger numbers and recognising numerals. We will also explore patterns and repeating patterns.

Literacy:

We will conduct Phase 1 Phonics activities a minimum of 3 times per week to support listening and attention and other phonics based skills such as rhyming. We will share our core book, focusing on retelling the story as a group using words and actions. We will continue to implement daily whole group fine motor activities such as 'squiggle whilst you wiggle' and 'dough disco' to support motor skills and mark making skills.

Understanding the World:

We will use our core book to discuss healthy eating and healthy choices. We will explore materials with different properties. We will discuss differences and similarities and support children in sharing their own experiences and home lives.

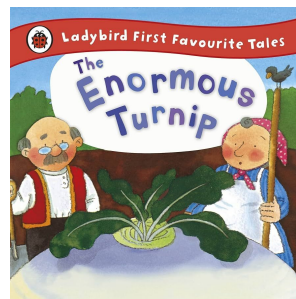
Expressive Arts and Design:

We will provide open ended resources to support imaginative and creative play. We will be taking part in World Nursery Rhyme Week supporting the children with learning and singing songs. We will continue to explore instruments to support children in rhythmic skills.

Physical:

We will have weekly PE sessions and moat sessions to support physical development. We encourage and support independence and will continue to do so in relation to toileting and hygiene routines.

Communication and Language:

We will be focusing on listening and attention through circle times and small group activities. We will support structuring sentences through an activity called 'colourful semantics.' In the Nursery we will play listening games which involve taking turns to support listening to each other.
