Reading in Year 6

All KS2 children have a login to **Rockerbox News**, a non-fiction reading platform that can be used to enhance their reading experiences out of school. Please also encourage your children to read the articles on here regularly.

Homework

Children will continue to be given a 'Menu' of homework activities at the beginning of the half term. This can also be found on the Pine Class Page of the school website. These activities cover a wide range of curriculum areas and the children are expected to complete an activity from each column to be handed in on a **Wednesday**. Homework books will be marked and returned the following day. This homework is to be completed alongside the activities set on Mathletics.

PE and moat days

We will continue to have PE on a **Wednesday** and **Thursday** this half-term so please ensure your child comes to school in an appropriate P.E. kit on those days. We are moving away from children wearing 'moat clothes' in school as the PTA have kindly purchased waterproof trousers suitable for all children; however, this shouldn't affect your Y6 children too much as our moat day will continue to be on a Wednesday (when they are wearing their P.E. kit). As the moat is becoming muddier in the wet weather, please do send your child in with a **change of shoes/wellies** that can be worn in the moat.
