

Below are details regarding Nursery routine changes. I change these sessions on a half termly basis to try and ensure all children have an opportunity to participate in the different experiences we can offer.

<u>Moat</u>

Moat Spring 1: Thursday mornings

With the colder weather please ensure your child is sent in clothing that covers arms and legs, coats, waterproofs (if you own them), wellies and hats and gloves. Please ensure children have spare clothes, socks, underwear and shoes in their bags to change into afterwards.

Library

Library Spring 1: Monday mornings

If your child attends Nursery on Monday mornings they will join us in visiting the Library in the Key Stage 2 building. This provides us with the opportunity to focus on sharing stories and supporting the children in looking at and talking about the story and illustrations. Your child will have the choice of choosing a book to take home with them. If your child does bring a book home, we plan to provide a new book once the old one is returned on a weekly basis; however if your child would like to keep their book for a longer period of time we are happy to support this.

This is just a reminder that the way we conduct Tapestry observations of children is now through a 'focus week' approach. You will be notified via a Tapestry memo when it is your child's focus week, and throughout that week we will create snapshots of your child's learning which we will then share with you on the Friday of that week as a 'learning story.' During the focus week we would love you to share your own pictures and observations of your child at home and the interests they have. We will use these pictures from home to conduct a 'show and tell' where your child can share their pictures with their friends in the Nursery group. We will still share 'wow moments' of children as and when they happen but our focus will generally be on the focus children of the week.
