Reading in Year 6

<u>Homework</u>

Children will initially continue to be given a 'Menu' of homework activities. This can also be found on the Pine Class Page of the school website. These activities cover a wide range of curriculum areas and the children are expected to complete an activity from each column to be handed in on a Wednesday. Homework books will be marked and returned the following day. This homework is to be completed alongside the activities set on Mathletics. As the half term progresses, we will begin to provide the children with some more specific Maths and English homework activities to complete each week. This is in preparation for their transition to secondary school, as well as the SATs in May.

PE and moat days

We will continue to have PE on a Wednesday and Thursday this half-term so please ensure your child comes to school in an appropriate P.E. kit on those days. As the moat is becoming muddier in the wet weather, please do send your child in with a change of shoes/wellies that can be worn in the moat.
