SATs

Whilst we are mindful of not putting our Year 6 pupils under any undue pressure regarding SATs, we do feel it is important for them to fully understand the process and how the tests will be administered in school. As such, we will be having a 'dry-run' in the week commencing **25th November.** There will be a parent's information evening regarding SATs at the beginning of new year including ideas for how to support your child at home and suggested revision materials. In the meantime, we encourage parents to support their child by: hearing their child reading every day and checking their understanding of that they have read; practising spellings; completing tasks set on mathletics that link directly with what we have been learning in class and encouraging your child to check any written task homework for accuracy of punctuation and spelling.

<u>Homework</u>

Children will continue to be given a 'Menu' of homework activities at the beginning of the half term. These activities cover a wide range of curriculum areas and the children are expected to complete an activity from each column to be handed in on **Wednesday** please this half-term. Homework books will be marked and returned the following day. This homework is to be completed alongside the activities set on Mathletics. Homework will increase throughout the year which will include additional Maths, SPAG (Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar) and Reading task.











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PE

We have PE on a **Wednesday** (netball) and **Thursday** (dance) this half-term so please ensure your child comes to school in an appropriate P.E. kit on those days.
