Happy New Year and welcome back to the school! I hope you all had a restful holiday and are as excited as we are to begin this new term.

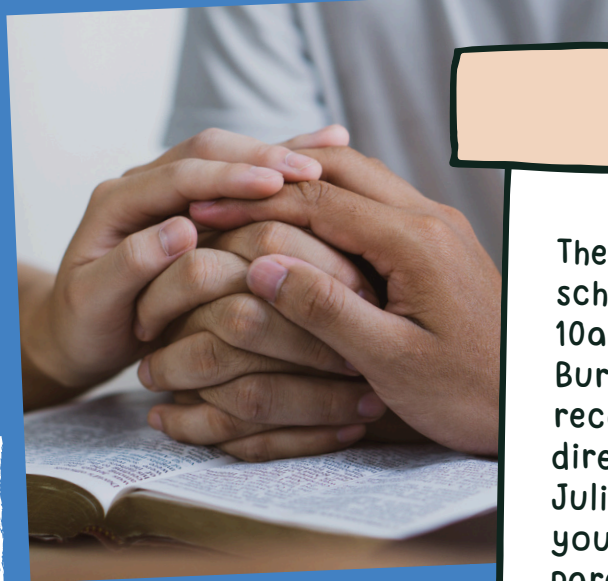

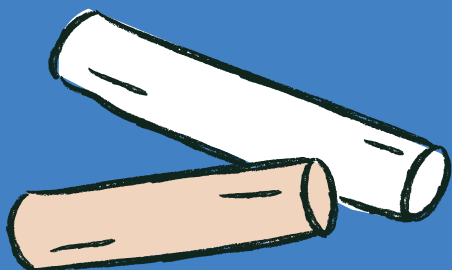
