Headteacher Message

Dear Parents and Carers,

It's wonderful to be starting this summer term, with lots of exciting opportunities and events ahead. I've included a long list of key dates within this newsletter to help you stay informed and ensure you don't miss anything.

This term, we're introducing something new across the school: the 5-Point Scale. This simple tool helps children (and adults!) reflect on how they're feeling:

- 1 Feeling Great: Calm, positive, ready for the day
- 2 Feeling Okay: Things are manageable, feeling steady
- 3 Feeling Uneasy: A little worried or uncomfortable, but coping
 - 4 Feeling Worried/Anxious: Needs some attention or support
 - 5 Feeling Overwhelmed: Finding it hard to cope, needs immediate support

We're using the 5-Point Scale as part of our commitment to CARE, the core value that underpins everything we do. It's a way for us to check in regularly with each other, with curiosity rather than judgement—an opportunity to celebrate positivity, but also to notice when someone might need extra care and support. You might hear your children talking about it at home, and you may even want to try it together as a family!





Finally, we're also taking a moment to say farewell (but not really goodbye) to two members of our team. Mrs Lambell is leaving to follow her passion for yoga teaching, and we're delighted that she hopes to return to Stapleford in the future to lead yoga sessions for our children.

Miss Hill is moving on for a truly special reason: she is adopting a little girl. We're absolutely thrilled for her as she begins this exciting new chapter, and we look forward to welcoming her back for a visit soon. Both Mrs Lambell and Miss Hill have given so much to our school, and we know you will join us in thanking them for their dedication, care, and commitment to our children.
