Wishing Miss Watson, one of our amazing office team, all the best as she leaves us on Friday, 5th, to welcome her new baby!

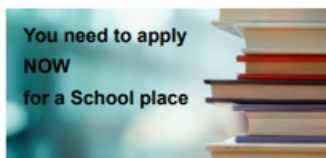

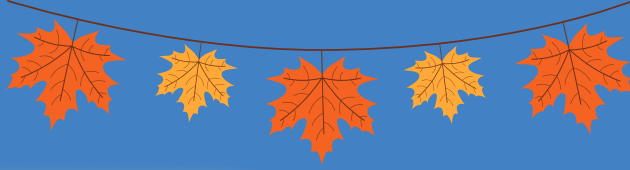
We loved seeing their excitement and response to this experience as everyone joined in together!
