

Maths:

This term we will support children in exploring play based Maths skills such as using puzzles, counting and singing number rhymes. We will explore and name different colours to support further Maths knowledge. We will look at different patterns and teach and model use of size language e.g. shorter/taller, longer, smaller, bigger.

Expressive Arts and Design:

We will support the children in exploring different materials such as paint, playdough and sticking. We will introduce instruments, naming and exploring the sounds of the instruments in circle times and supporting children in using and understanding rhythm. We will provide opportunities for pretend play through small world toys and role play areas.

Communication and Language:

We will support all children in understanding the rules and expectations within the Nursery environment. We will begin listening and attention activities such as games and story times. We will implement circle times two times per day to support children in group situations and in becoming confident to talk to others about their thoughts and interests.

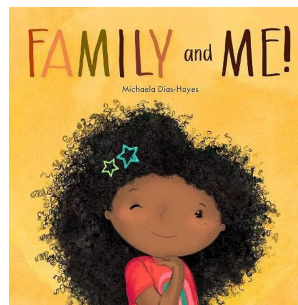
Literacy:

We will be exploring fine and gross motor movements to support children's physical development which filters into their Literacy skills. We will be implementing daily exposure to stories and nursery rhymes. After the settling in period, we will implement small group Phonics activities a minimum of three times per week which initially focuses on listening and attention skills. We will provide opportunities for children to explore their mark making skills using sand, sticks, pencils, paint and many other materials.

We will implement small group activities to help the children in building relationships with staff and their peers. We will begin our learning about emotions, naming and describing different emotions to support the children in expressing their own feelings.
