As Mathematicians,

We will match pictures and objects. Identify a set. We will explore sorting techniques and sort objects to a type. We will compare amounts.

We will compare size, mass and capacity. We will explore and create simple patterns.

We will find 1, 2 and 3. We will subitise and represent 1, 2 and 3.

As Readers and Writers,

We will join in with repetitive phrases in shared stories.

We will learn reading behaviours e.g. holding books the right way up and knowing the difference between words, pictures, pages, etc. We will be hearing, saying and writing letter sounds and will be learning to recognise different sounds in our daily phonics lessons. We will be using these sounds to begin reading and writing words.

We will be listening to stories about families and other important people.

We will make marks or write letters and tell an adult what we have written. We will begin to write our names.

As Scientists,

We will be finding out about our bodies, how we grow, naming different parts and learning how our senses tell us about the world. We will look at and notice seasonal changes such as signs of autumn both through learning inside and outside of the classroom including our visits to the Moat.

<u>Computing:</u> we will be exploring the class' technology resources, including remote control cars, beebots and writing tablets and investigate how different forms of technology are used for different purposes.

As Design Technicians

We will be exploring different ways to construct models, using recyclable materials and construction kits. We will experiment with different joining techniques, including using sticky tape, glue and staplers.

We will be physical by joining in our P.E. lessons where we will explore a range of different ways to move.

We will also be using different apparatus in the garden, including bikes, scooters, bats and balls and stilts.

As Historians and Geographers,

We will be finding out about where we come from and where we live. We will look at a world map and talk about where we live in Stapleford.

We will experiment with colour and how it can be changed.

We will explore different painting techniques.
