Welcome back and welcome to Year 2! We have hit the ground running already, with the children learning routines and preparing themselves for the new academic year. We have an exciting year planned and are looking forward to working alongside yourselves to ensure a great year!

#### **Topic**

We are excited to start the new school year and the transition into Year 2 with our topic all about Beatrix Potter, in which we will be learning about Beatrix Potter's life and what it would have been like to be a child during the Victorian period and writing stories with our own animal characters! ### **Additional Adults**

## P.E

In PE, the class will be covering a wide range of skills, but our main focus this term will be fitness and team games. The children will require their PE kit: a plain red T-shirt, shorts or jogging trousers, navy or black sweatshirt and suitable footwear for outside activities. We are asking that children come in already dressed in their P.E kit on their allocated P.E days. Our set days for P.E. are Monday and Thursday.

#### Forest School

We will be taking part in weekly Forest School sessions at the moat each Wednesday afternoon. The children should wear school uniform on these days. We will provide the children with waterproof trousers, to protect their school trousers/ bottoms. However please supply an old coat/jumper to protect the top half of their uniform for the session. As the weather begins to change through the term, it is important that the children bring wellies or similar footwear.

## Home Learning

In the first few weeks of term, all children will be assessed on their reading and will be sent home a book of an appropriate level. This should be practised at home and brought back for changing as soon as the book is completed. Please do write notes in your child's reading record about how they have read, as it helps us to better support them in class and ensure they have the correct reading book band.
